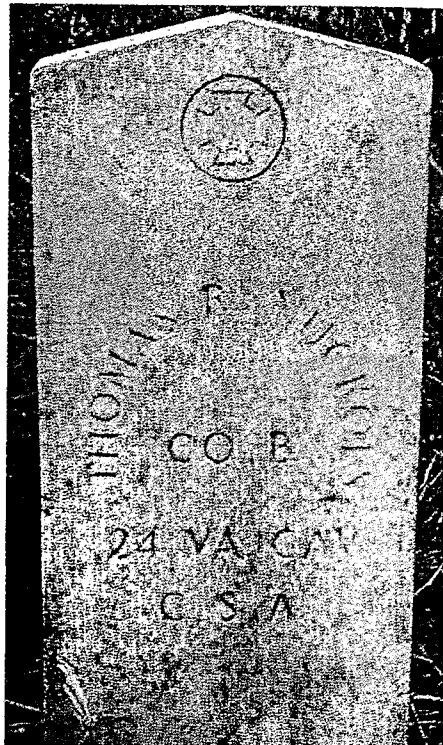

BURIAL SITES OF CONFEDERATE SOLDIERS IN GOOCHLAND COUNTY

Introduction

Anyone who has ever searched for a gravesite knows the frustrations encountered. These include: only a last name on the stone with no initials; three initials but no name; no indication of sex; common last names in same cemetery; duplicate names in cemetery with no dates; only birth or death date, or no dates at all; the source document used by the searcher has different dates from the stone; names misspelled in the source document; worn engraving on stones; no indication of whether the cemetery is Black or White; lack of access to the site (legal or physical); no stone at all; etc. When looking for a Confederate grave the same problems occur. However, Confederate graves may be marked only by an iron Maltese cross which provides no information. Or there may be both a cross and a stone. Sometimes CSA and/or the unit are on a family stone. Many Confederate graves have an engraved granite stone provided by the Veterans Administration listing name and unit and sometimes dates.

Reading the List

If the individual has been identified, any and all dates are listed following the name. Dates may come from one or more sources. If a person has not been positively identified, the place of burial is listed followed by "May be" followed by name, unit and any dates. Some birth/death dates are approximate. Many men served in more than one unit due to total disbanding of the unit, merging with another unit, or individual transfer. For example, the Goochland "Turner" Artillery did not last the whole war. It was disbanded and many of its men ended up in the King William Artillery. Some soldiers transferred from the infantry to cavalry, some men in the cavalry lost their horse, could not get another, and ended up in the infantry. Unit(s) are listed following the name in case of positive identification or by "May be" when identification is uncertain. The men from Goochland served in many different units, but the units with Goochland roots were:

Goochland Light Artillery (aka Guy's Battery)
Goochland "Turner" Artillery (aka Leake's Battery)
Co. F, 4th Va. Cavalry Regiment (aka Goochland Light Dragoons)
Co. H, 2nd Va. Artillery Regiment (later Co. H, 22nd Va. Infantry Battalion)
Co. F, 23rd Va. Infantry Regiment (aka Goochland Grays)
Co. B, 44th Va. Infantry Regiment (aka Goochland-Byrd Rifles)
Co. D, 44th Va. Infantry Regiment (aka Ambler Grays)
2nd Co. H, 46th Va. Infantry Regiment

Unfortunately, a list such as this can never be 100% correct or complete. Any input from readers as to corrections and/or additions would be welcomed. The compiler assumes responsibility for any errors.
